Br. F.R. Foran, B.A., M.A.

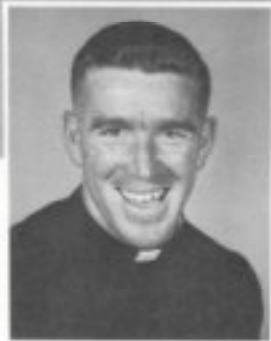


Br. R.C. Post, B.A.
